

### **Europe & Ireland's Construction Skills Needs**



#### Irish Fiscal Advisory Council

- Ireland's infrastructure is lagging 25% behind that of high-income European economies.
- It estimated 80,000 workers are needed to address Ireland's infrastructure needs.
- Raising productivity in the construction sector could be key to improving Ireland's infrastructure provision.
- This would mean fewer workers would be required to carry out these infrastructure projects.
- Applying modern methods of construction could help raise productivity in the construction sector.
- If productivity were to increase to the average of high-income European countries, then employment levels would need only increase by 19,300 workers, rather than 80,000.


